Use variants of introductions such as

Hello! my name is	What is your Name?
Good Morning, my name is	What is your Name?
Good Afternoon, my name is	What is your Name?
Good Evening, my name is	What is your Name?

Quickly revise this, by randomly picking up a student and asking,

- Its 7 in the morning, introduce yourself.
- Its 2 in the afternoon, introduce yourself.
- Its 8 pm, introduce yourself.

(If the children do not understand, AM and PM, then revert to Morning, Noon, Afternoon and Evening)

(Please note--You have just introduced the different parts of the day to the children)

(Use either Class/ Standard, depending on what's familiar to the children)

If the children, belong to the same class, they should realise that they all have the same answer to this question.

Introduce the concept of "WE". "We all study in "4A standard"

(Please note--You have just reiterated the concept of pronouns and plurals to the children. Avoid explaining the grammar rules in detail)

Choose any of the below activities

- 1. Divide the children in groups, ask them to name their groups in English. Give them a theme, for eg. Flowers, fruits, colours, cricket teams, etc Call one student each from 2 different groups to the front of the class. Each student introduces him/her self and asks the question to the other child. Allot points to the group, ½ marks when they ask the right question and ½ marks for answering right.
- 2. Share the sheet- "All about me" with the children. Ask them to fill in all their details. Help the children with the right spellings.
- 3. Ask the children to write down their introductions in their English note books. Help the children By writing the sentences on the board.
