Algebra Formulas


$(a + b)^2 = a^2 + 2ab + b^2$	$(a - b)^2 = a^2 - 2ab + b^2$

Distance between two points



Breath


Don't try to "calm your mind." If your mind starts wandering, recognize it and return to appreciating the sensations of your breath.

Arms

Relax your shoulders and arms, letting your hands rest on your thighs. Place one hand on another in your lap.

Legs

If you're sitting in a chair, keep your feet flat on the floor and your spine straight. If you're sitting cross legged on a cushion, have your knees below your hips.



Emotions

Long-term meditators show increased size in brain regions associated with emotional regulation, which may help cultivate positive emotions.


Eyes
